

Research at GNLU to get a 'chair' boost

Ahmedabad: Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) has received a major boost to its consolidation of research mission with the establishment of two chairs by a public trust and leading law firm of the country. Under the GNLU Navinchandra Desai Law Foundation Chair, GNLU will provide as-

sistance to lawyers and students to develop their skills and to continue legal research and publish research works and undertake internship in intergovernmental organisations.

Graduating students will be provided a monthly stipend of Rs 10,000 for one year, every year, based on merits and selection process. It will also provide financial

assistance of Rs 50,000 to a student to pursue research internship in an inter-governmental organisation such as the United Nations.

Leading law firm Cyril Amarchand and Mangaldas and Co. too established a dedicated chair to provide a forum for discussion and study of legal and judicial ethics and values (LJEV) and other relevant issues.
