



BLOOD DONATION CAMP - GUJARAT NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY, GANDHINAGAR

The Legal Services Committee which is under the aegis of the GNLU Centre for Law and Society (GCLS) conducted the Annual Blood Donation Camp in the premises of Gujarat National Law University (www.gnlu.ac.in) as part of its 13th Foundation Day celebrations.
