

GNLU pupils engage in MUN dialouge

A Model United Nations (MUN) conference is being organised for the first time at the Gujarat National Law University (GNLU). With a view to engage students in a dialogue on world issues, the MUN Society of GNLU has organised the three-day conference. Inaugurating on Friday, it will witness a panel discussion on 'Youth Participation in Governance in India'.

"The participation of youth in governance is a pressing issue. It does not link to politics alone, but also has relevance in several other arenas. The panelists would certainly add valuable insight on the matter," said Tania Sebastian, assistant professor at GNLU.

The discussion will be moderated by Sonia Singh, editorial director of NDTV. Issues that will be taken up for discussion at the conference include, a debate over minimum voting age by the UNDP, and making gender-based budgeting goal-oriented and more effective, among a few.
