Report blames Ministry of Transport and transport commissioner for not taking action

n a report issued by the Gujarat National Law University on Tuesday, it was informed that a meeting was recently conducted to discuss the securitv issues along the Knowledge Corridor in Gandhinagar. The report states that despite several requests to the Ministry of Transport as well as the Commissioner of Transport with regards to the same, no action had been taken till now.



Despite the rise in number of rash driving cases in the area, no arrangement had been made to keep a check. The report claims that there are no police or traffic personnel deputed in the area for the security of the student

and staff.

It further mentioned, "The streetlights in the area also don't function at times. This poses issues for the commuters and pedestrians passing by after sunset. Besides this, the major problem the area faces is rash driving and frequent traffic violations. The traffic department should look into the matter and act accordingly."

The university had earlier tried urging the transport department to impose fine on traffic violators in this area, but received a cold response.
