People who love watching courtroom scenes on television will have a reason to rejoice.

Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) will soon give a live experience of visiting the Supreme Court courtroom that would otherwise have remained an impossible dream.

The 3D dioramas (a miniature representation) of the Supreme Court courtroom will be set up at the Indian Legal History museum of GNLU. It will be the first ever legal history museum in Asia. The entire set up will take one and a half year to complete.
