GNLU to train RBI law officers

AHMEDABAD: In a first of its kind training to be held at GNLU, a two-day intensive workshop for 45 law officers of Reserve Bank of India will be organized to impart advanced knowledge of specific laws, legal procedures and policies. The training will focus on Companies Act-2013, laws of procurement, tender and documents, interpretation of statutes and services jurisprudence, income-tax and by-laws, international and electronic contracts, formal legal writing and research methodology.

It will be conducted by a sitting judge of Gujarat HC, resource persons and experts from RBI, SEBI, ministry of corporate affairs and specialist academicians. Resource persons from IMF, World Bank and Asian Development Bank will give information on best practices.
