

GNLU introduces new short-term courses

Ahmedabad: To provide practical learning to students, the Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) has decided to offer tailor-made, short term, refresher intensive courses starting winter semester- 2014. These courses are aimed at helping students who wish to pursue litigation as a career after graduation, said a note from the institute.

GNLU will offer courses in three subjects – criminal procedure code, civil procedure code and taxation. "While GNLU offers the above courses as part of the regular curriculum, the proposed short-term courses will

be provided at a reasonable course fee, in close collaboration with senior advocates and advocates from Gujarat High Court," stated the note.

The short-term intensive courses will focus on specific modules of a broader subject. For example, the short-term course on Civil Procedure Code will focus on practical aspects of appeal, review, revision and reference at high court. The courses will be spread over a 4 to 6 week period with a minimum learning duration of 14 hours followed by an evaluation test. The proposal was made by students of the 2009 batch during their meeting with GNLU director Bimal Patel in July.
