## Highest pay package at GNLU goes up this year

The highest annual pay package was between Rs 15 lakh and Rs 16 lakh, against Rs 13 lakh-Rs 14 lakh last year; the average remained the same at Rs 10 lakh



he highest annual salary package offered during placements of students of 2013-18 batch of the undergraduate programme of Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) was between Rs 15 lakh and Rs 16 lakh. This was higher than the Rs 13 lakh-Rs14 lakh range last year. However, the average is Rs 10 lakh, the same as last year, said Nidhi Buch, faculty and placement coordinator at GNLU.

According to officials, of 180 students in the batch, 110 had participated in the placement. Of them 87 students, or 79.10 per cent, were placed through campus recruitment facility. Of these, 49 students were offered jobs by law firms and nine by lawyers' chambers/litigation. One was placed with a regulatory authority, four in policy making, one by a PSU, 19 by corporate/financial institutes and two by academic institutes. Two students got fellowship.

According to officials, 14 students opted for higher studies in India and overseas, six are preparing for competitive exams including judiciary and civil services while one opted to pursue a career in entertainment industry.

"In law institutes, students/institute get to know the salary on the day

they get the offer letter or join the organisation. Among those who were made offers with specific salary figure, the highest package is between Rs15 lakh and Rs16 lakh per annum this year," said Buch.
