Gayatrivedi of 2013-18 batch earned five gold medals. Hail-

ing from a family of bankers she credits her teachers at GNLU for being able to pursue his studies at Oxford. "It was very difficult here. GNLU gives so many opportunities and it is up to oneself how one utilises them," she said.

Justice AK Sikri of the Supreme Court, who gave the convocation address, joked that he is glad that he and Justice DY Chandrachud, who presided over the convocation, studied law four decades ago, saying it would have been very difficult to win gold medals today given the presence of so many bright girls.

Sagar: Girls bagged almost 90 per cent of gold medals on offer at the Gujarat National Law University's ninth convocation held on Sunday. Of the 51 gold medals that were distributed, 45 were won by girls. A total of 32 students bagged the 51 gold medals, including six boys, who each won a gold medal, and 26 girls.

In all, 462 students got their graduation certificates, of whom, 232 — just over half — were girls. Akarshita Dhawan, a student from 2012-17, won
