NCW chairperson holds regional consultation

Ahmedabad: Rekha Sharma, chairperson of National Commission for Women (NCW), conducted a meeting with state representatives from Gujarat, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Goa, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh at Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) on Saturday for regional consultation.

The group carried out discussions on two topics — Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 and and Women's Property Rights.

NCW representatives mentioned that the regional consultative meets are being held this month to compile issues and suggestions which can be sent

to the central government for formulation of national policy and amendments if any.

"Movements like 'Me Too' threw light on certain shortcomings and issues in implementation of sexual harassment at workplace," said an official.

Talking to reporters in Gandhinagar, Sharma lauded Gujarat as one of the safer states for women.
