The Villain induces him to pass his time drinking and gambling so as to forget the condition. The family lawyer finds the hero on the eve of his twenty-fifth birthday and persuades him to go home. On his way to home, the hero meets a beggar girl and out of compassion gives her shelter for night. The next day, the lawyer turns with a special marriage license and insists on immediate marriage. The hero marries the beggar girl.

Decide whether the defendant's play infringes the copyright in the plaintiff's play. Examine 'idea-expression' dichotomy and the requirement of 'originality' under the copyright law with help of decided cases. Discuss the doctrine of merger.
