a) An oil mill is being run in front of your client's house for all the 24 hours. The residents of the locality find that the din is intolerable and the noise is so great that they cannot sleep well at night. During the day also the locality is not quiet because of the mill. Your client feels the nuisance because he is nearest to the mill. He instructs you to lodge a complaint in the Court of the Magistrate praying that he should take suitable action.

Draft a complaint to that effect on behalf of your client. You are free to assume any facts necessary to make the complaint complete in all its details, including the designation of the Court in which the complaint is to be lodged.

- c) List the broad outlines that should be followed while drafting a 'Will'. Draft a specimen 'Will'.

A license agreement was entered into between the plaintiff and defendant in respect of premises belonging to the plaintiff.

The agreement provided that the licensor (The plaintiff) could terminate the license at any time by giving a 3 months' notice in writing to the licensee [The defendant].

In spite of such a notice having been sent, the defendant has not vacated the premises and the plaintiff now seeks for possession.

A tenders the mortgage-money on the due date, but B refuses
