They have thrown the luggage of some passengers outside the train including Mukesh. Guide Mukesh about making a claim for his loss of luggage worth INR 20,000 before appropriate forum. Answer with relevant provisions and case laws.	(10)
Q.2 Mr Vadivel has approached the State Bank of India [SBI], Chennai, for getting a loan. He is in need of 20 lakhs. He has given his house property worth INR 40 Lakhs as securities. After considering his application, the bank has granted the loan worth INR 10 lakhs. Mr. Vadivel is thinking of approaching the Banking Ombudsman for enhancing his loan amount. Guide Mr. Vadivel for resolving his grievance through Banking Ombudsman with relevant provisions and case laws.	(10)
Q.3 Suresh and Ramesh have a property dispute which is pending before Ahmedabad City Civil Court. Suresh is requesting the Court to refer the dispute for arbitration under section 89 of Code of Civil Procedure. Whether the trial court can refer the same dispute for arbitration under section 89 of Code of Civil Procedure or not? Please explain your answer with relevant provisions and case laws	(10)
Q.4 “Enhanced technology, high office rent, traffic and long commute times, work/life blend and a desire to better serve clients have resulted in the creation of a new way to practice law: the virtual law firm.
