- Q.1 ABC Airline transported a celebrity dog on a flight from Chicago O'Hare International Airport, US to Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi, India. Dog seemed to be in good health upon arrival in India on 4 January 2017. Shortly afterwards, dog became visibly ill. It died on 14 January 2017. Autopsy conducted on 15 January 2017 revealed the cause of death as "pleuro pneumonia probably brought on by the stress of travel." A final autopsy report conducted on 21 January 2017 concluded that temperature fluctuations in the cabin of the airplane probably caused the illness causing death. On 25 January 2017, plaintiff gave written notice to ABC Airline and claimed hefty damages. Decide the claim.
- Q.2 "World has seen a number of instances of an international civilian aircraft being attacked and destroyed by armed forces of a country. Such incidents have always shaken the international community, irrespective of the nations involved. They generally acquire political overtones, complicating the matter further. However, regulatory framework for this purpose exists."

 Discuss the above-mentioned statement in the light of the efficacy or otherwise of international regime for regulating such acts citing specific examples.
- Q.3 "Ensuring Safety and security of international civil aviation needs high degree of collaboration amongst nations. International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) has its own mechanism to ensure it. US and EU too have adopted different approaches and mechanisms to strengthen it.
